WARM WEATHER ARRANGEMENTS

With the early arrival of summer we would like to remind you of our arrangements for warmer weather. We ask that everyone adheres to the school dress code which is that children wear tops with sleeves to prevent their shoulders from sun burn. In addition to this, footwear should be suitable for the playground (no loose strap sandals or clogs). Thank you for your support with this. We have three chilled drinking water stations in the school, funded by the PTA. Children are encouraged to bring water bottles into school. It is important that these are taken home to be washed each day. We ask that children do not bring fruit juice or squash as an alternative to water.
