



Dear parents and carers,

As you know from previous newsletters, the school will be **closed on Wednesday to all children, except those in Y3 and Y4**, due to strike action from the NEU. Children in Y3 and Y4 should attend as usual and any absences reported to the school office.

There will not be any set remote education but families wishing to complete school work should visit [Oak National Academy](https://www.nationalacademy.org.uk), where there are lessons for all age groups.

As Extended Services staff are not members of NEU, they will be working as usual. Please see the below arrangements for clubs:

### **Breakfast Club and After School club**

Breakfast club and After School club will be running as usual.

Children in Y3 and Y4 can attend as normal.

If any other parents/carers would like to send their children to either Breakfast club or After School Club they will need to be dropped off and collected at the school office.

Breakfast club: drop off at school 8.00am and pick up at 8.45am

After School Club: drop off at 3.30pm and pick up at 5.45pm.

If your child's class is not at school that day and you choose not to go to either breakfast club or after school club your account will be credited for the cost of these sessions.

### **Enrichment Clubs**

Some enrichment clubs will still be running on Wednesday. If the club is cancelled your account will be credited. If the club is running all children booked in will be charged. If your child's class is not at school that day please arrive in time for your club and drop children off at the school office.
